Brief Bio

Bishop Bruce Lewandowski is originally from Toledo, Ohio. As a priest of the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (The Redemptorists), he served in Hispanic Ministry in East Harlem, The Bronx, and Philadelphia. For three years he ministered in St. Lucia, West Indies. He was the Vicar for Cultural Ministries in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia 2010-15. In 2015, he was assigned by the Redemptorist Provincial to Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish in Baltimore, Maryland, to serve as rector and pastor. In 2019, he was appointed the Archbishop's Delegate for Hispanic Ministry for the Archdiocese of Baltimore. He was nominated auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Baltimore by Pope Francis on June 10, 2020, and ordained to the episcopacy on August 18, 2020. He serves as the Vicar for Hispanic Catholics and the Vicar for Baltimore City. He occasionally gives retreats and parish missions.
